



# BOIL WATER NOTICE

## WATER MAIN TIE-IN

### OKANAGAN FALLS WATER SYSTEM

#### LOWER ZONE ONLY

March 17, 2025

The Regional District of Okanagan-Similkameen (RDOS) is issuing a **Boil Water Notice** that will go into effect **Thursday, March 20, 2025, at 8:00 am** for the **entire Lower Zone** of the Okanagan Falls Water System (see links below and/or page 2 for Lower Zone description). This notice is required to facilitate the completion of the watermain upgrade project that is underway in the laneway between the north end of Ash St. and Cedar St.

The contractor completing this work will require the RDOS to conduct two partial shutdowns in the Lower Zone to connect the new watermain to the existing distribution system. A Boil Water Notice is typically required when the distribution system loses full or partial pressure. This **Boil Water Notice** will remain in effect until further notice.

Residents are advised to use a safe alternate water source or to boil water for all drinking, toothbrushing, food preparation/cooking purposes, and ice-making. Water should be brought to a full boil and allowed to boil for at least one (1) minute.

Residents are reminded to use a safe alternate source of water for preparing baby formula for infants and young children during this time due to the potential for elevated manganese levels resulting from the disruption of sediments in the water mains.

Please be advised that RDOS Public Works crews will be flushing the watermains in the localized area of the shutdown after completion of the tie-in works.

Residents may observe some discolouration or sediment in the water. If you experience dirty water, run your cold water taps only and/or garden hose until the water runs clear. Residents may also wish to isolate their in-home treatment systems until turbidity has decreased to normal levels. In addition, residents should check the water quality before laundering clothing during this time to minimize potential staining or discolouration.

The RDOS would also like to remind all business owners/operators (bed and breakfasts) and public facilities operators that it is the responsibility of these establishments to notify your customers of the **Boil Water Notice**.

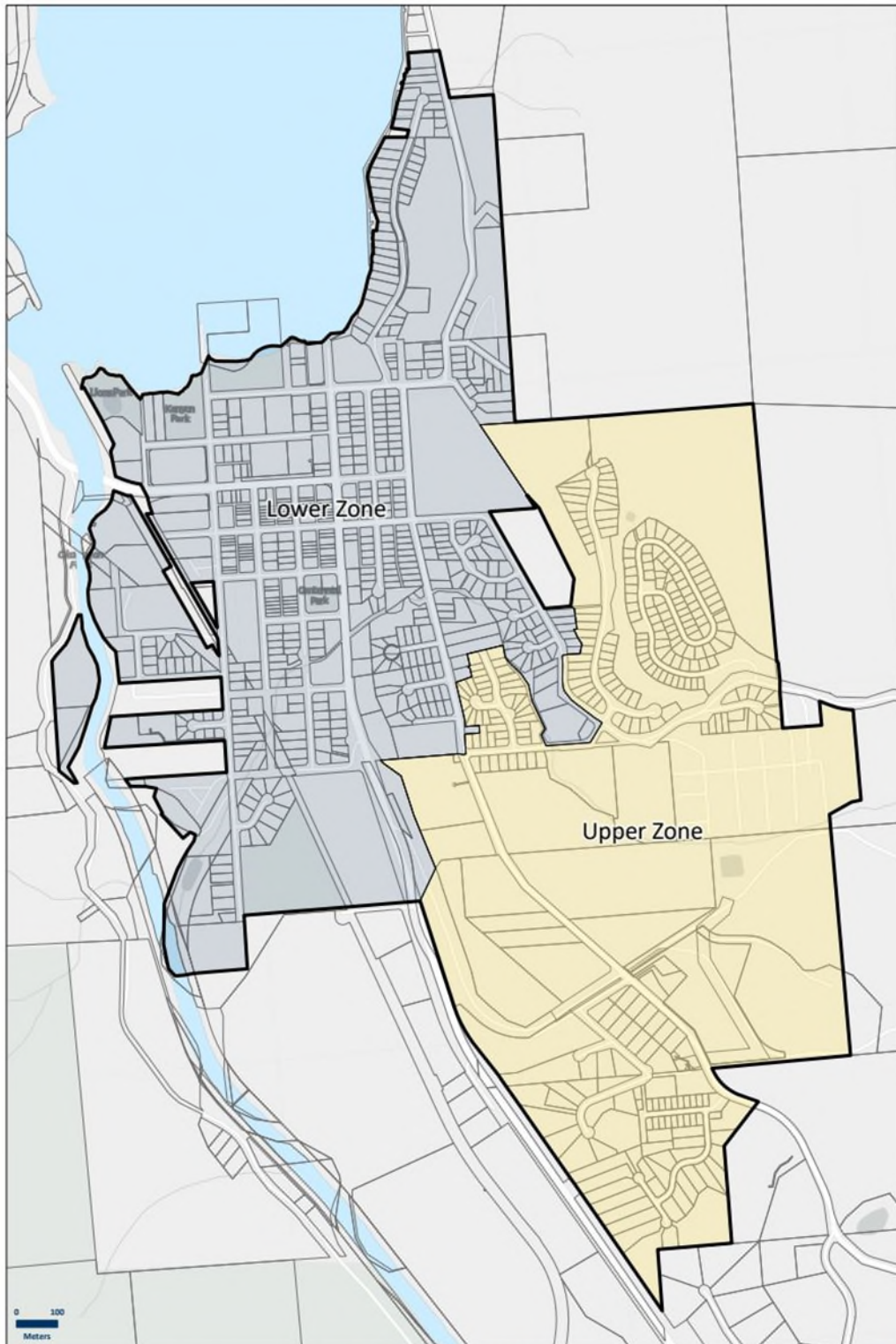
