Anyone who chooses to disregard this Evacuation Order and remain in the area does so at their own risk. The Regional District of Okanagan-Similkameen and first responders may be unable to assist anyone who chooses to remain in the Evacuation Order area.

Whereas a declaration of a state of local emergency was declared on August 12, 2026 by the Regional District of Okanagan-Similkameen pursuant to Section 95 of the *Emergency and Disaster Management Act* due to the Bald Range Wildfire (K51490);

And pursuant to Section 107(1)(c) of the *Emergency and Disaster Management Act*;

This **Evacuation Order** has been issued by the Regional District of Okanagan-Similkameen due to the immediate danger to life safety caused by Bald Range Wildfire. This Evacuation Order is effective as of August 14, 2026 at 10:00am for the following areas:

- Properties bordering the East Area H Boundary, including 5723 PRINCETON-SUMMERLAND RD

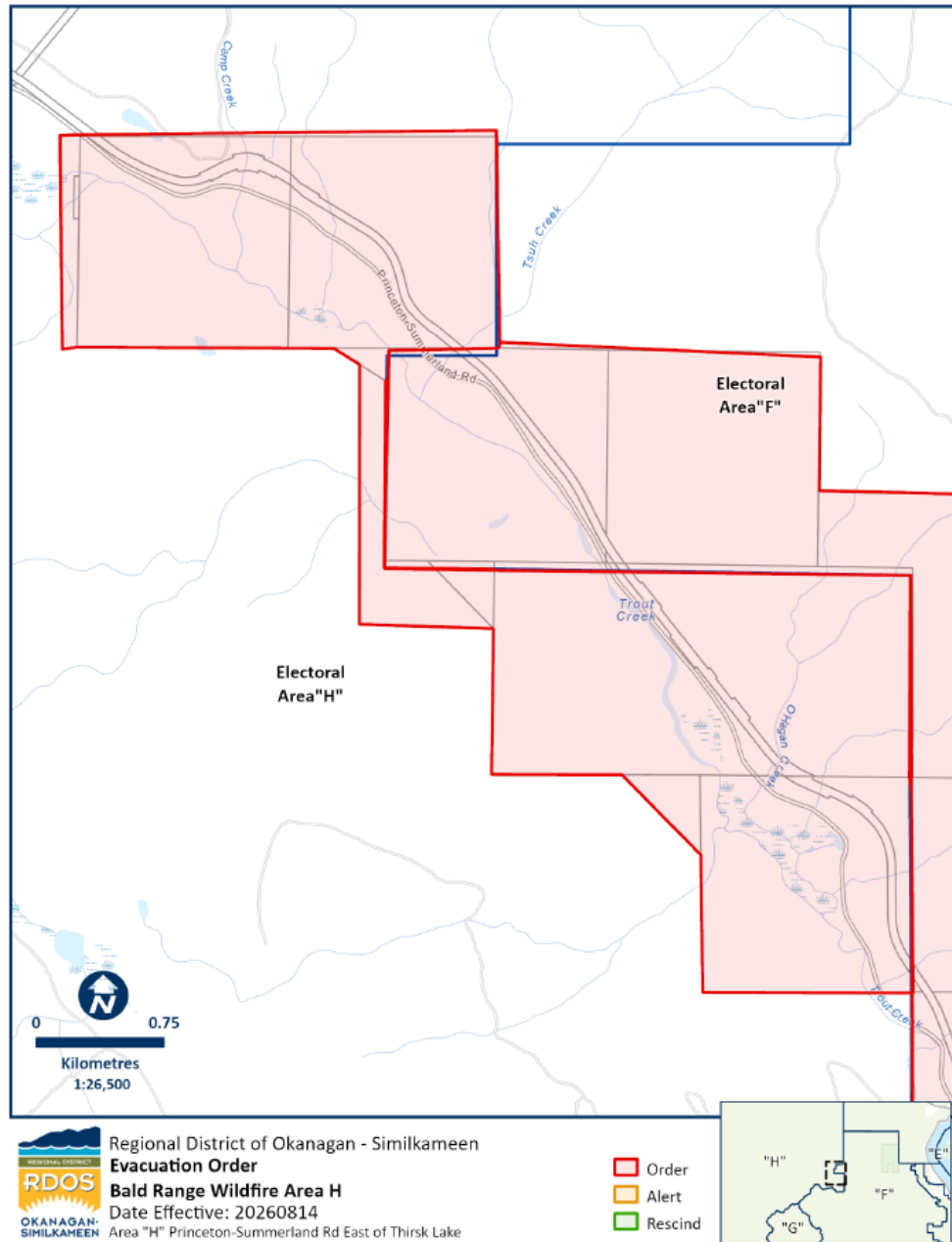
