Apex Fire Protection Referendum


On Saturday, March 27, 2021, eligible electors were asked to vote on Apex Mountain Fire Protection Service Establishment Bylaw No. 2920 and Apex Mountain Fire Protection Loan Authorization Bylaw No. 2921.

The project was proposed as the Apex Fire Brigade formally approached the Regional District of Okanagan-Similkameen (RDOS) to create a Regional District fire protection service, to be administered in the same way as existing Regional District fire departments. Residents and property owners of Apex were asked whether they supported authorizing the RDOS to establish a service for the provision of fire protection and borrow up to \$3,000,000 in funds to purchase a fire truck, equipment, and acquire land to construct a fire hall.
