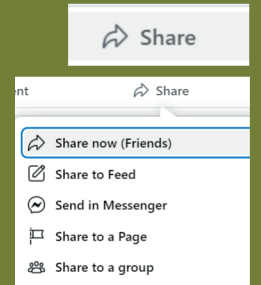

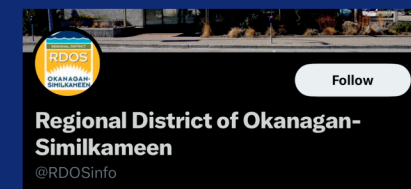
## How to share information on Facebook:
