RE: Public Hearing Report - Amendment Bylaw NO. 2498.16, 2021

Purpose of Bylaws:

The proposed amendments to the Electoral Area “H” Zoning Bylaw No. 2498, 2012, are related to correcting typographical errors and mapping inconsistencies, updating maximum floor areas and allowable units for secondary suites and accessory dwellings, and introducing “Scientific Research Facilities” as a permitted use in the Resource Area (RA) Zone.
