

BOIL WATER NOTICE

OKANAGAN FALLS WATER SYSTEM

HODY DRIVE ONLY

November 17, 2023

The Regional District of Okanagan Similkameen, in consultation with Interior Health Authority, is issuing a **Boil Water Notice** for residents along Hody Drive within the Okanagan Falls Water System. This is in response to a water main break on the morning of November 17, 2023, which resulted in loss of pressure within the distribution system in this area. Hody Drive is located in the Lower Zone, as per the map below.

Residents may observe some discoloration or sediment in the water. If you experience dirty water, simply run a cold water tap only, preferably an outside tap and/or garden hose until the water runs clear, weather permitting. Minimizing the amount of hot water usage will limit the amount of sediments that could potentially settle out in your hot water tank. Residents may also wish to isolate in home treatment systems until turbidity has decreased to normal levels. In addition, residents should check the water quality before laundering clothing during this time to minimize potential staining or discoloration.

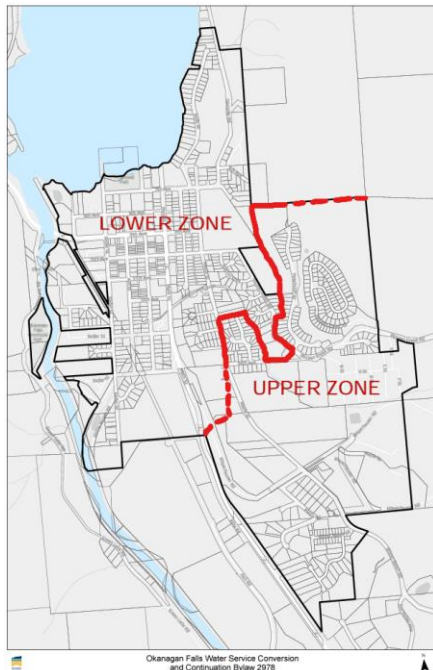
Residents are reminded to use a safe alternate source of water for preparing baby formula for infants and young children due to the potential for elevated manganese levels.
