

Glossary

Adaptable - Able to live in a changing environment.

Carcass - A dead animal.

Carnivorous - An animal that eats meat.

Climate - The usual weather in an area.

Communicate - Letting others know what you are feeling by making sounds or using body language.

Conservation - Taking good care of animals, plants and the environment, so that they remain healthy.

Dominance - Being the boss.

Dormant - Asleep, but ready to wake up if necessary.

Ecosystem - A place where air, water, soil, plants and animals exist as a unit.

Endangered - Only a few plants or animals left and soon there could be none.

Excavating - Another word for digging.

Grizzled - Having silver-tipped fur.

Habitat - The type of environment an animal needs in order to survive.

Herbivore - An animal that eats only plants.

Nursing - Drinking mom's milk.

Nutrition - Good healthy food.

Omnivore - An animal that eats both plants and animals.

Population - The total number of people, plants or animals living in an area.

Prey - Animals that are eaten by other animals (called predators).

Range - The area where an animal lives, sleeps and finds food.

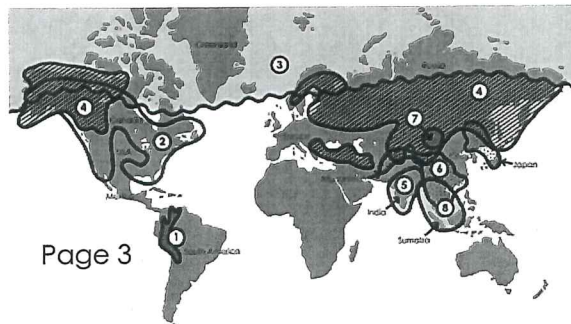
Scat - Poop.

Vulnerable - When the number of plants or animals left in a population is only a couple of steps away from being endangered.

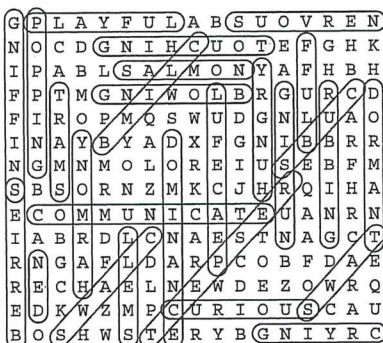
