The Regional District of Okanagan-Similkameen is currently recruiting for a temporary (July 2023-May 2024), full-time Manager of Emergency Services to join our team. This position is the key contact for the Electoral Areas and member municipalities in matters of emergency preparedness, response and recovery and will be available as necessary to perform designated functions during emergencies.

The successful candidate will have extensive knowledge of the BC Emergency Management System, the Incident Command System and the roles and responsibilities of the local authority under the *BC Emergency Program Act*. This position also requires working flexible hours (evenings and weekends) under stressful conditions, particularly during emergency situations.

QUALIFICATIONS

- Degree in emergency management or public safety from an accredited educational institution. An equivalent combination of education and experience may be considered.
- Completion of supplemental emergency management coursework through the Justice Institute of BC.
- Professional designation in emergency management is considered an asset.
- Minimum of five (5) years experience in a related role, preferably in local and/or regional government. Experience must include serving time as an emergency management professional.
- Minimum of one (1) year experience in a supervisory role.
- Completion of the WorkSafeBC [Supervising for Safety](#).
- Ability to pass and maintain a criminal record check.
- Valid BC Driver's Licence.
