

## NOTICE TO ALL NARAMATA IRRIGATION CUSTOMERS

## **IRRIGATION TURN-OFF**

The Regional District of Okanagan-Similkameen Public Works crew will commence fall irrigation turn-off the week of:

October 21, 2024

## Please take the necessary precautions to winterize your private system.

While this notice is for those with separate irrigation connections, it is also a great time for homeowners to check the Pressure Reducing Valves (PRVs) inside their homes and/or on their irrigation systems in high-pressure areas to check they are working correctly or need replacing.

- PRVs help protect plumbing fixtures from damage or breaks that may cause wasteful leaks
- Life expectancy for PRVs is approximately 10 years
- Signs of high-pressure can be:
  - → Banging heard in pipes (water hammer)
  - → Water spitting out of faucets, warn washers, and intermittent toilet 'hiss'

To protect and prevent your backflow prevention device from freezing, the RDOS suggests draining equipment after turn-off and either covering or ideally removing the device for storage. High-pressure blow-outs can cause damage to the backflow preventer and should not be used.
