



BOIL WATER NOTICE

MISSEZULA LAKE WATER SYSTEM

May 11, 2026

The Regional District of Okanagan-Similkameen (RDOS) has issued a **Boil Water Notice** for the Missezula Lake water system, effective immediately. This notice is in response to a failure in the chlorination system and will remain in effect until further notice.

All residents are advised to use a safe alternate source of water or to boil water for all drinking, tooth brushing, food preparation/cooking purposes and ice making. Water should be brought to a full boil and allowed to boil for at least one (1) minute.

The RDOS would also like to remind all business owners/operators (bed and breakfasts) and public facilities operators that it is the responsibility of these establishments to notify their customers of the Boil Water Notice.
