Local governments and Indigenous nations are a crucial part of the licensing process. Section 33(1) of the [Cannabis Control and Licensing Act](#) prevents the general manager from amending a CRS licence, to permanently relocate the CRS, without a positive recommendation regarding the CRS relocation application from the local government or Indigenous nation.

The LCRB is requesting Okanagan-Similkameen Regional District to consider the relocation and provide the LCRB with a written recommendation with respect to the application. The information that must be included in your recommendation is the same as that required for a new CRS licence application.
