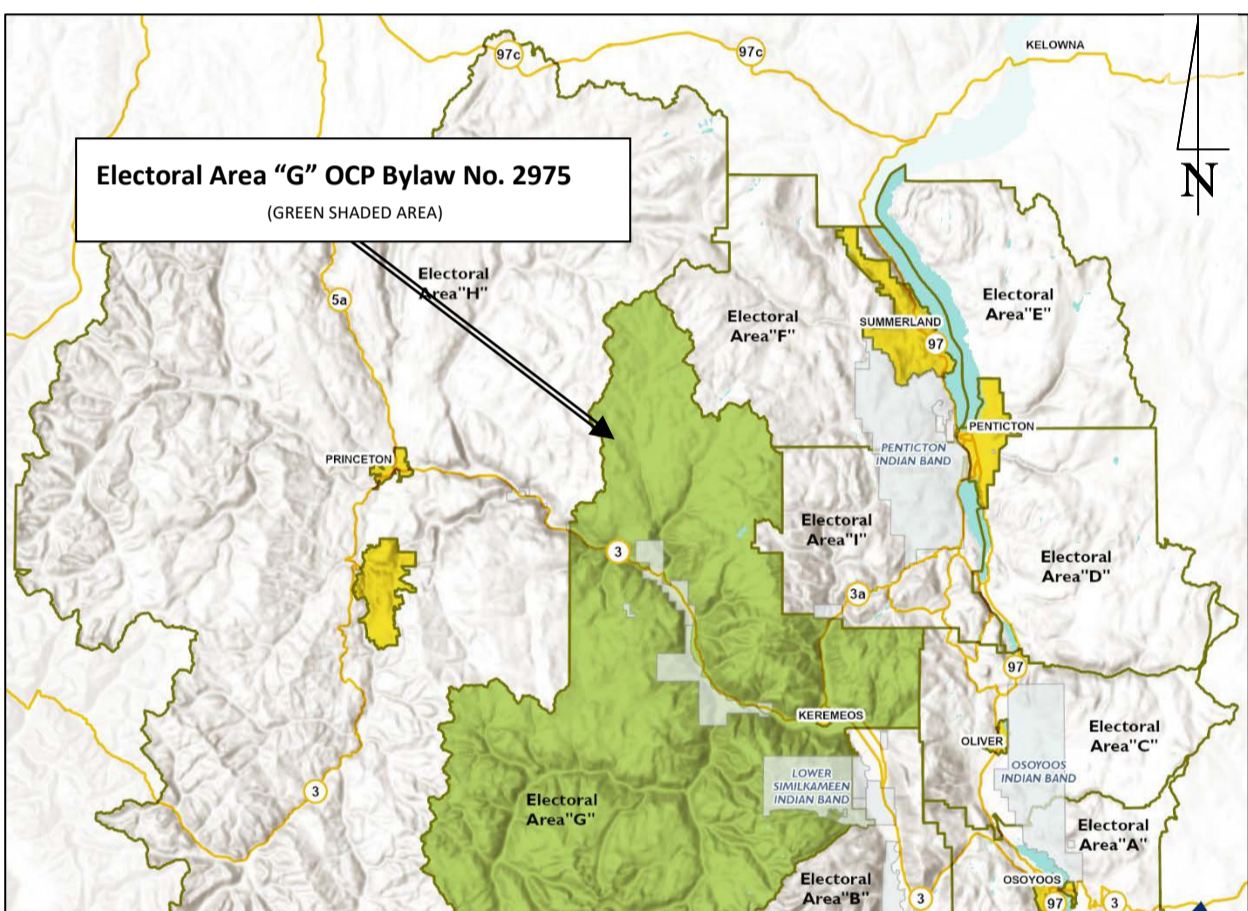
Official Community Plan Bylaw No. 2975

Notice is hereby given by the Regional District of Okanagan-Similkameen (RDOS) that all persons who believe that their interest in property is affected by the **Electoral Area “G” Official Community Plan Bylaw No. 2975, 2022**, will be afforded a reasonable opportunity to be heard or to present written submissions respecting matters contained in the proposed bylaw at a delegated public hearing which will be reconvened on:

Location:	702-4th Street, Keremeos

*Project team will be available to answer any questions regarding the OCP during the Q/A period.

It is being proposed that an Official Community Plan (OCP) Bylaw be enacted for Electoral Area “G”. The OCP bylaw introduces a “Vision” statement and “Broad Goals” that reflect the priority of the residents in the community while including objectives and policies of the Regional District Board with regards to land use and development in the Plan Area. The bylaw also introduces Local Area Policies specific to rural Keremeos, Hedley, and Olalla.
