Purpose of Bylaws:

The proposed amendments to the Okanagan Valley Zoning Bylaw No. 2800, 2022 are to address a number of errors identified in Schedule '2' (Zoning Map) of the Okanagan Valley Zoning Bylaw No. 2800, 2022, and that applies to the following properties:

- Lot 133B, Plan KAP2897, District Lot 2450S, SDYD, Except Plan 15135 (5647 Cactus Street);
- Lot 6, Plan KAP719, Section 24, Township 88, SDYD, Portion SE ¼ (530 Oak Avenue);
- an approximately 0.2 ha area adjacent Linden Avenue near its intersection with Oak Ave;
- Lot 2, Plan KAP65691, District Lot 395S, SDYD, (177 Clearview Crescent); and
- Lot 1, Plan KAP30202, District Lot 194S, SDYD (705 Old Kaleden Road).
